5.0 Master Programmes

The University offers various Master Programmes as outlined in various areas. Master candidates can be registered in the relevant academic year.

5.1 To be admitted into a Master degree at Zanzibar University (General requirements): -

- i. A candidate must have obtained at least a good relevant Bachelor degree from a recognized institution of higher learning.
- ii. Candidates who wish to apply for Coursework and Dissertation Master Programme, a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.7 in 5.0 grade system is required from institutions where the Bachelor degree are classified.
- iii. Candidates who wish to apply for Thesis only Master Programme, a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 in 5.0 grade system is required from institutions where the Bachelor degrees are classified.
- iv. Candidates who wish to apply for Thesis only Master Programme, would be required to submit a synopsis of proposed study of 3-5 pages clearly indicating the title of the study, research problem and the objectives.

6.0 Ph.D Programmes

The University offers various Ph.D Programmes as in various areas, as outlined. PhD candidates can be registered throughout the year.

6.1 To be admitted into a doctorate degree at Zanzibar University (General requirements): -

- v. A candidate must have obtained at least a good relevant Master degree from a recognized institution of higher learning.
- vi. Candidates from institutions where the Master degrees are classified, a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 in 5.0 grade system is required.
- vii. An applicant would be required to submit a synopsis of proposed study of 3-5 pages clearly indicating the title of the study, research problem and the objectives.
