



## Call for Applications – Erasmus + Student Mobility for Study

The Public Relations Office of **Zanzibar University** announces a public call for Erasmus+ student mobility for studies to be implemented under the Erasmus+ KA171 project in cooperation with **Singidunum University** (Belgrade, Serbia). The mobility will be implemented during the academic year **2026/2027**.

Students are invited to apply for participation in the Erasmus+ mobility programme, which provides an opportunity to study abroad for one semester, gain international academic experience, and strengthen intercultural competencies.

### 1.1 Available Mobilities

Within this application round under the Erasmus+ KA171 project, the following mobilities are available:

- 2 mobilities for studies (expected duration: 5 months)

Host Institution: Singidunum University, Belgrade, Serbia

Planned mobility period: September 2026 – January 2027 (Autumn Semester)





## 1.2 Eligibility

Applicants must be enrolled as undergraduate students at Zanzibar University and should have completed at least the first year of study by the time the mobility begins.

## 1.3 Application Documents

Students must submit their application in English and include the following documents:

- Short CV in English with basic personal and academic information
- Motivation letter in English (indicating academic interests)
- Transcript of records / list of passed exams
- Proof of English language proficiency (minimum B2 level)
- Proof of disadvantaged socio-economic status or student disability (if applicable)

## 1.4 Selection Process

Student ranking will be based on academic performance, motivation letter, and English language proficiency (60 points), as well as an interview with shortlisted candidates (40 points).

Candidate selection will be conducted in accordance with Zanzibar University regulations governing the evaluation and selection of students for international mobility.

After the application deadline, all applicants will be informed of the selection results through the official Zanzibar University website.





### 1.5 Appeals Procedure

Appeals regarding the results of the selection process may be submitted within three days after the publication of results. Decisions on appeals will be made by the relevant university authority.

### 1.6 Application Deadline

Students must submit their application not later than **5<sup>th</sup> April 2026, at 11:00 AM**. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
